# ROBERT IS celebrating new life THIS EASTER!

Easter......2 "Now I have hope to see me through."......3 Help meet our Easter needs ......4 When Robert's elderly mother fell ill, he gave up his career and became her full-time, live-in caregiver. It was a labor of love. "I know God called me to take care of her," he says.

For the next four years, he looked out for her every need and the two grew closer than ever. Then she passed away unexpectedly and Robert was overwhelmed with grief. "I fell into a deep depression and couldn't even look for work."

He began numbing his pain with drugs and eventually wound up homeless, out on the streets in freezing weather. It was then he came to your Evansville Rescue Mission, where he found a warm bed, nutritious meals, and the opportunity for a fresh start. **"I came here because it was a very cold night, but I decided to stay because I wanted a better life."** 

Robert entered a track of our P.A.C.E.S. program (**P**urpose, **A**ccountability, **C**hrist, **E**ducation, **S**ervice), where his faith has grown strong through chapel services and Bible studies. **"I've learned to be still and know that the Lord is always going to be there for me,"** he says. "I have hope to see me through." Christian counseling and life skills classes have helped Robert process his grief and develop healthy coping skills. "The Mission has given me tools to stay on the right track and stay focused on my sobriety. I've been clean for 22 months now," he says proudly.

He's now looking forward to finding a job and saving money for a place of his own. "Everything is falling into place," he says. "My future looks bright."
